The Erasmus+ is a European programme for education, training, youth and sport for the period 2014-2020. It funds academic mobility and projects, which are involved in [three main key actions](#). Under the key action 1: [Mobility, Learning Mobility of Individuals](#). The programme funds mobility and cooperation between “programme countries” and “Partner countries” (in 2018, 33 programme countries that involve the 28 EU Member States and five other European countries). And, **CBHE, Capacity-building projects in the field of higher education** is under the [key action2](#). CBHE projects are transnational cooperation projects, based on multilateral partnerships, primarily between Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) from Programme and eligible Partner Countries. In the following, we present some statistics concerning Tunisian Erasmus+ projects.

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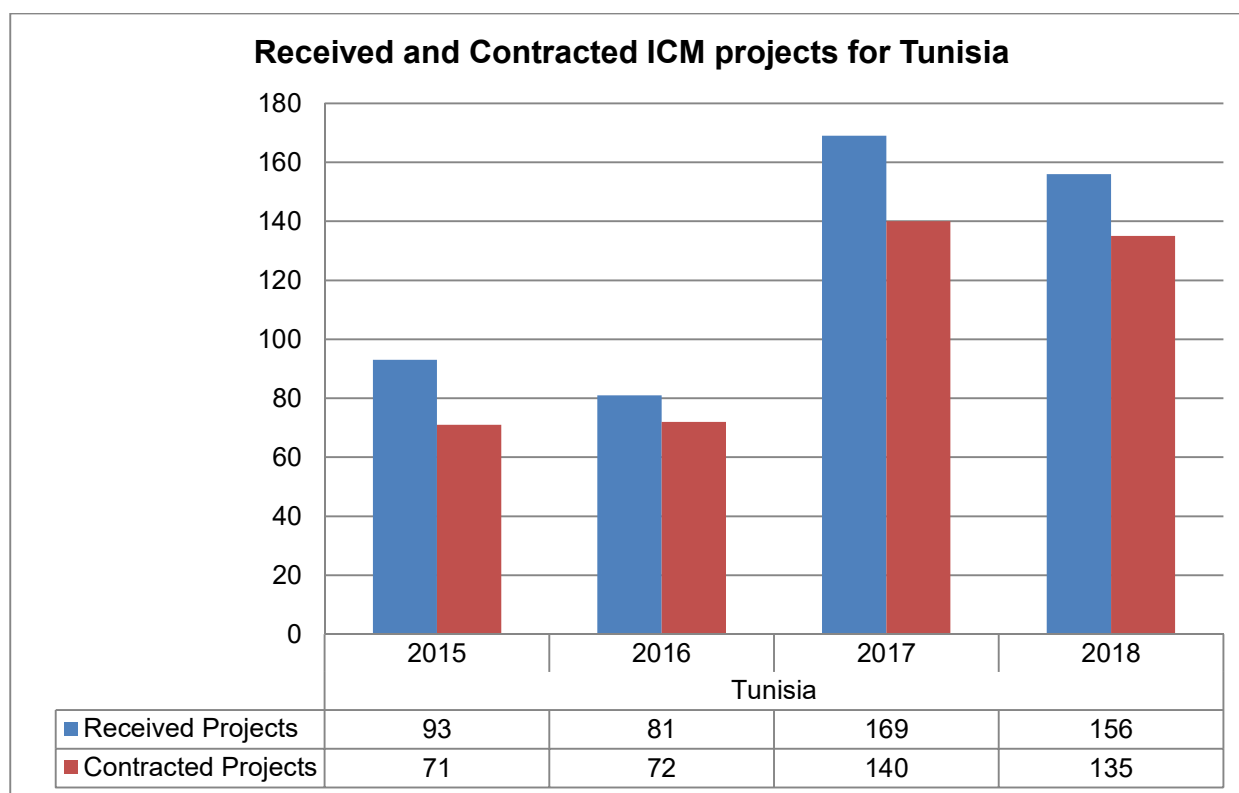
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1. Erasmus+ ICM Mobility in Tunisia

The Erasmus+ is a European programme for education, training, youth and sport for the period 2014-2020. It funds academic mobility and projects, which are involved in [three main key actions](#). Under the key action 1: [Mobility, Learning Mobility of Individuals](#). The programme funds mobility and cooperation between “programme countries” and “Partner countries” (in 2018, 33 programme countries that involve the 28 EU Member States and five other European countries).

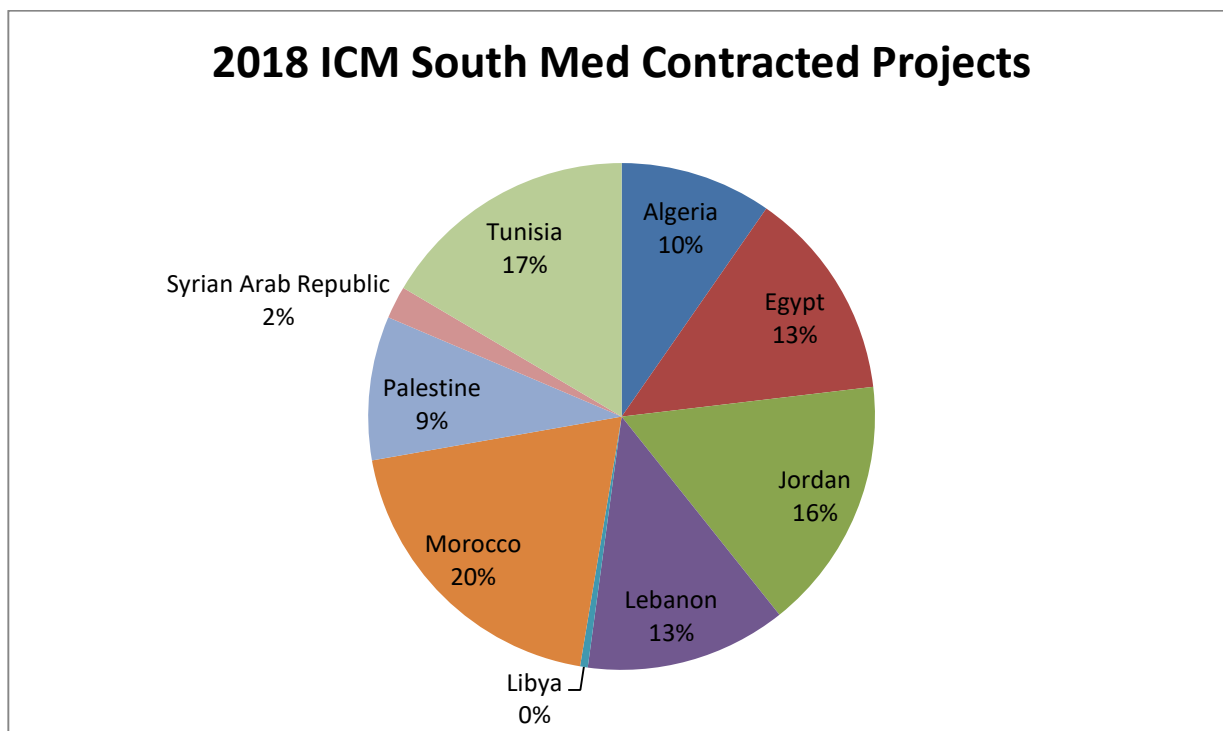
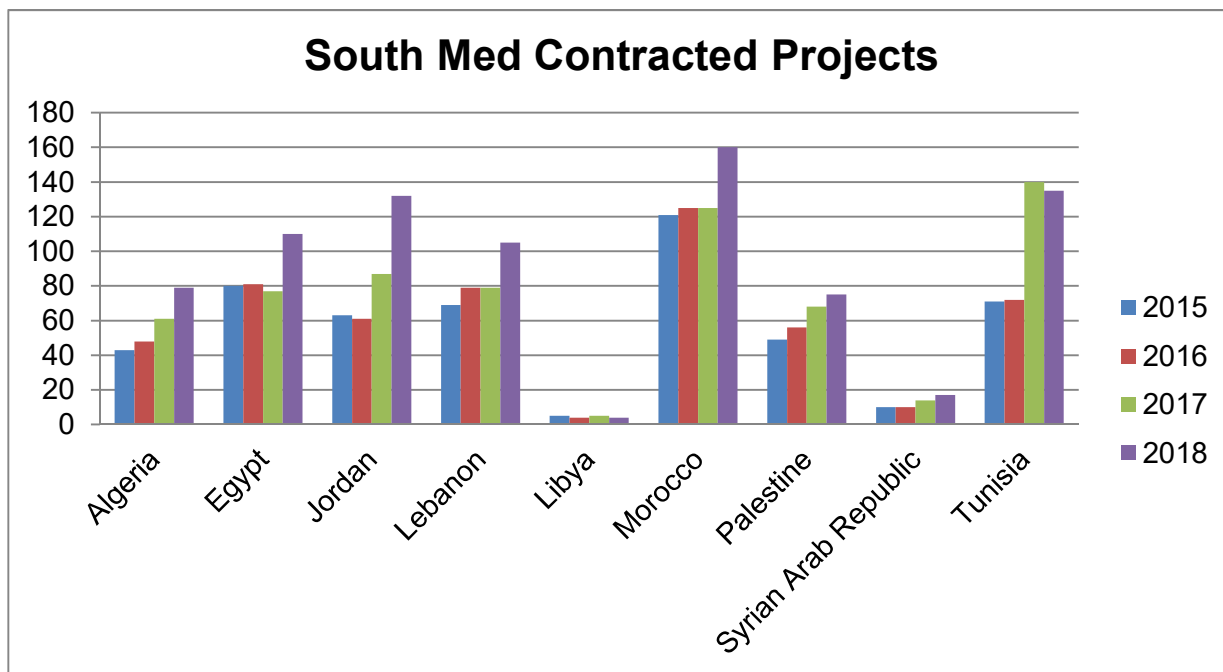
The International credit mobility, ICM or KA107 for short, which is a part of the Mobility, Learning Mobility of Individuals action, offers mobility for students, researchers, and staff, for over 30 years. The country program institutions establish bilateral partnerships with universities in the southern Mediterranean countries and apply on behalf of their partners. In the 2019 budget, the European Commission is providing additional €3 million Euro funding for Tunisia to the International Credit Mobility action.

Since the 2019 ICM projects’ results are not yet published, we provide in the following 2018 and previous years statistics. In 2018, Tunisia ensured 135 ICM contracted projects with a grant budget of a 5311857 Euro.



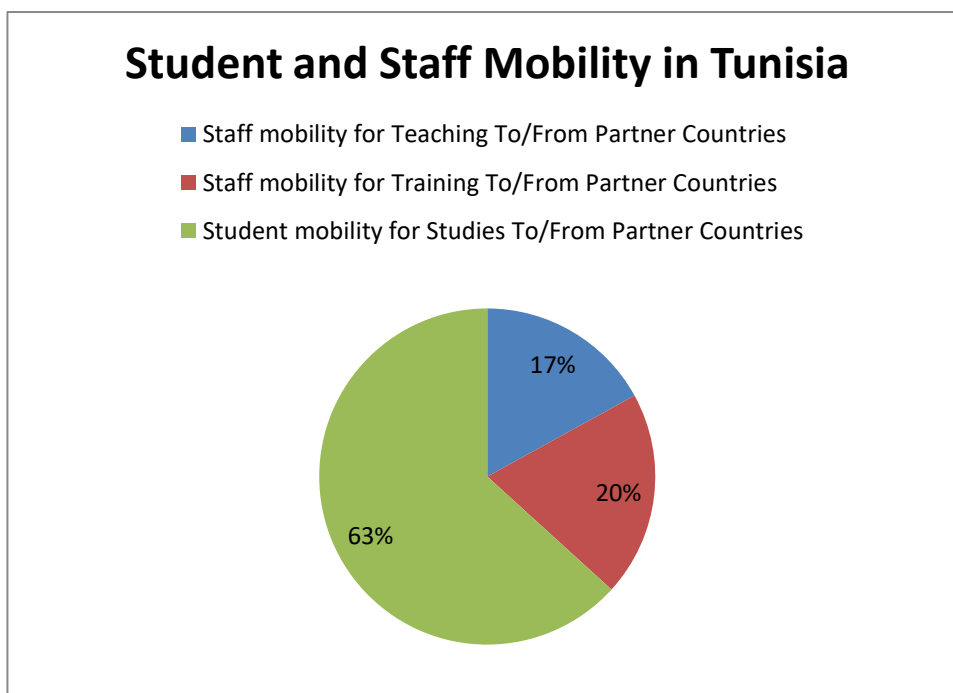
1.1 ICM in Tunisia and South Med Countries

Through the Majority of South Med countries, Erasmus+ 2018 Contracted ICM mobility in Tunisia represents 17% of the total contracted projects within those countries.



1.2 Students and Staff Mobility in Tunisia

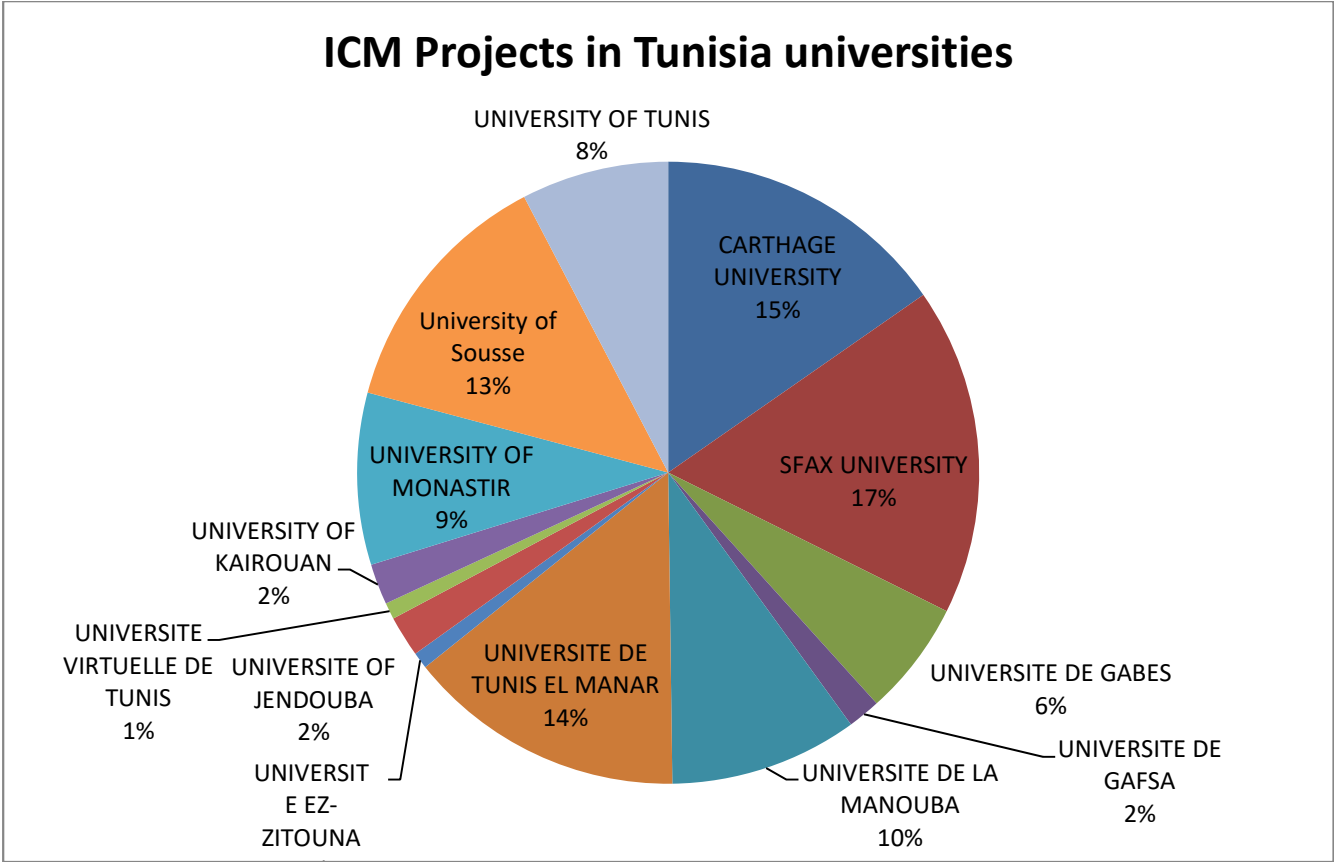
Student mobility represents 63% of total ICM mobility, whereas Staff mobility, with both Teaching and Training categories, represents 37%.

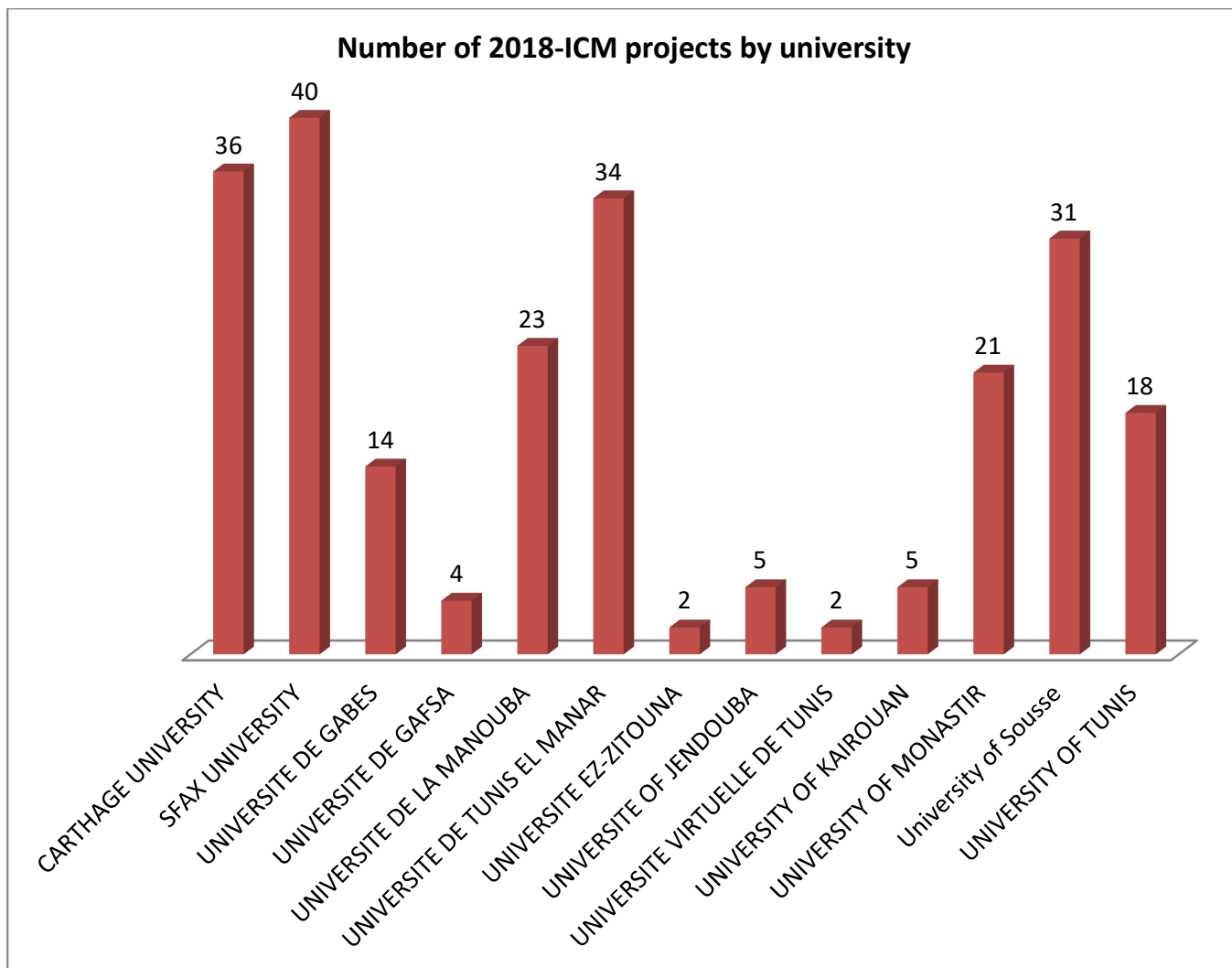


Those mobility are two-way From/to programme-countries/Tunisia allowing students to study at a foreign university for 3 to 12 months and earn credits which are then recognized by the sending institution as part of their degree. From 2018, traineeships are also possible. There are also grants for staff mobility from 5 to 60 days.

1.3 ICM in Tunisia Universities

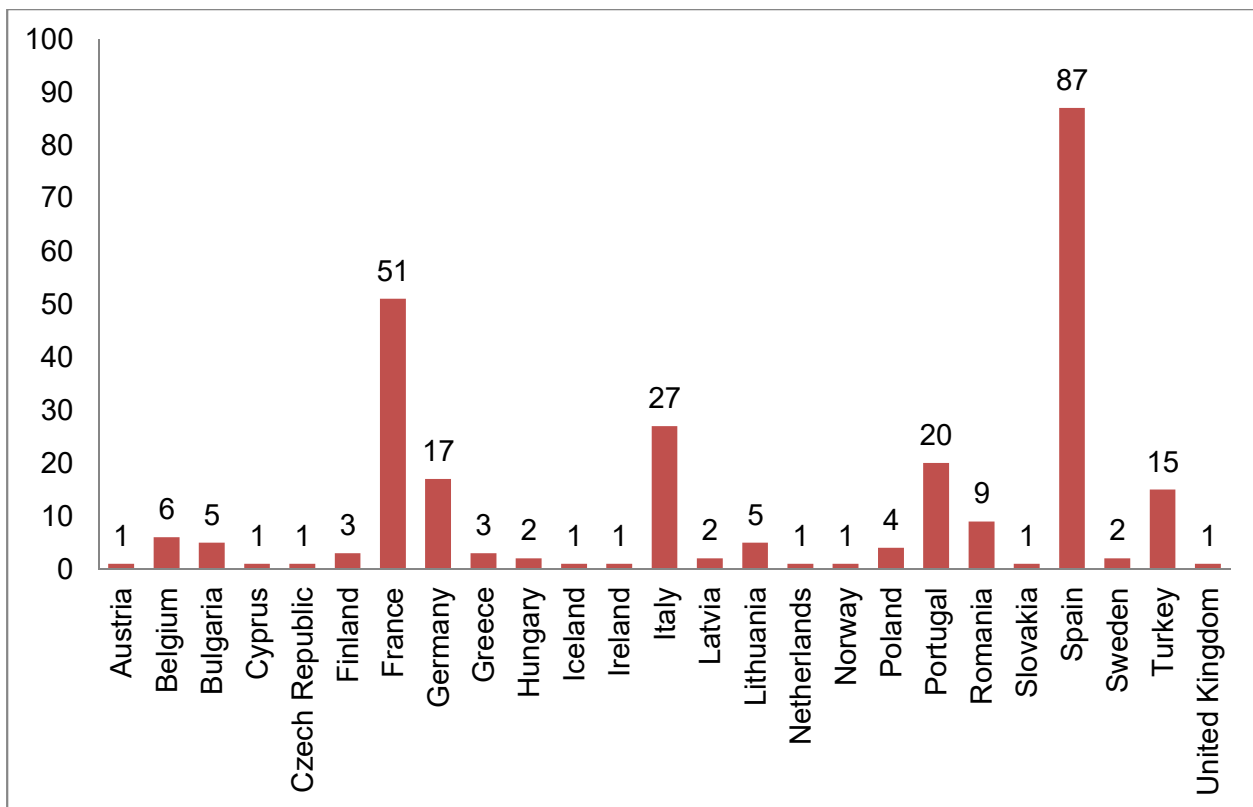

We can highlight that the geographical repartition of countries, plays a big role in the ICM Tunisia's exchanges partnerships destination, which is mostly with its neighbourhood, Spain, France, and Italy.



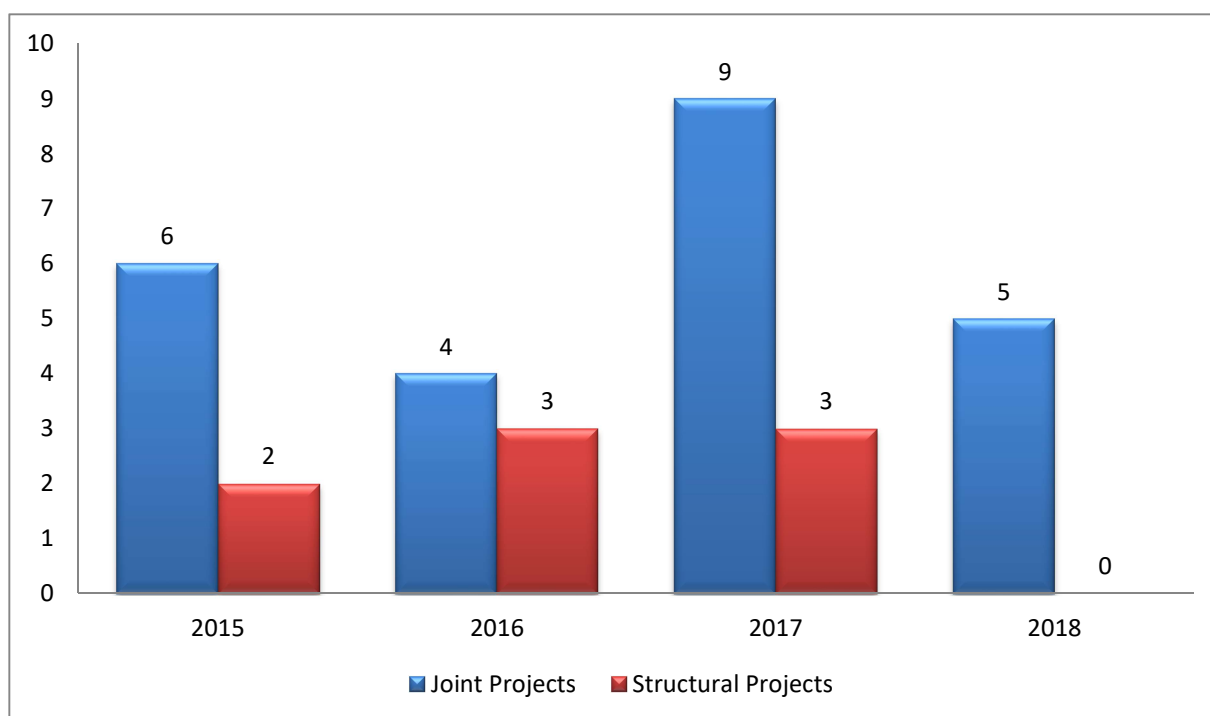
2. Erasmus+ CBHE Projects in Tunisia

CBHE, Capacity-building projects in the field of higher education, is under the [key action2](#). CBHE projects are transnational cooperation projects, based on multilateral partnerships, primarily between Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) from Programme and eligible Partner Countries. The goals of Erasmus+ CBHE (E+ CBHE) projects are mainly to support partner countries to:

- Modernise, internationalise and increase access to higher education,
- Modernize the governance and management of HEIs,
- Strengthen university/socio-economic world relations,
- and develop curriculums.

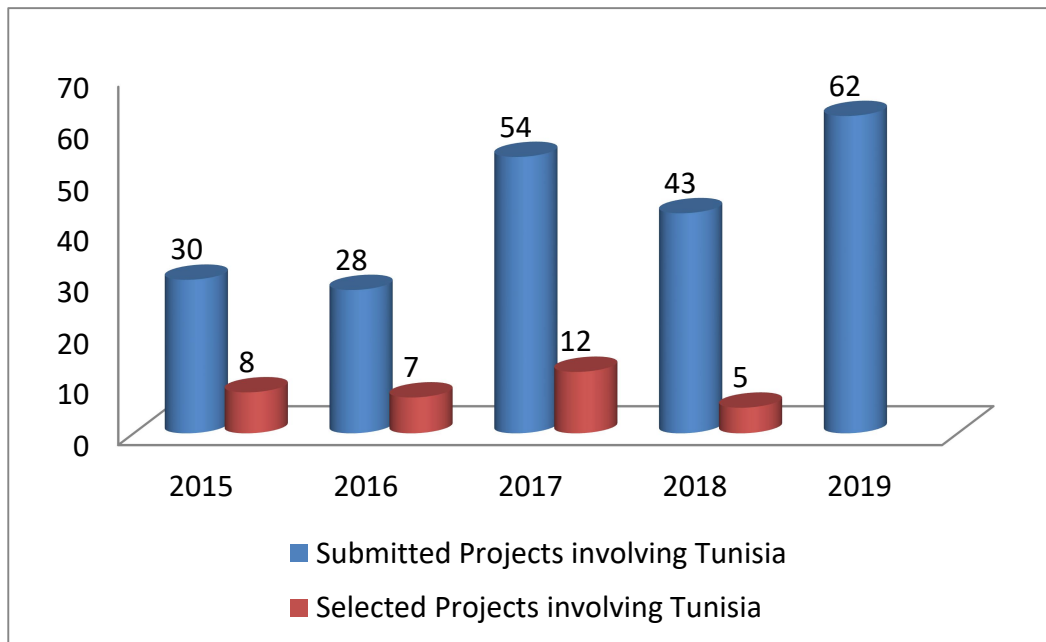
2.1 Number of Accepted Tunisia E+ CBHE Projects

By differentiating between structural and joint projects, we present in the following the number of accepted overall Tunisian CBHE projects from 2014 to 2018.



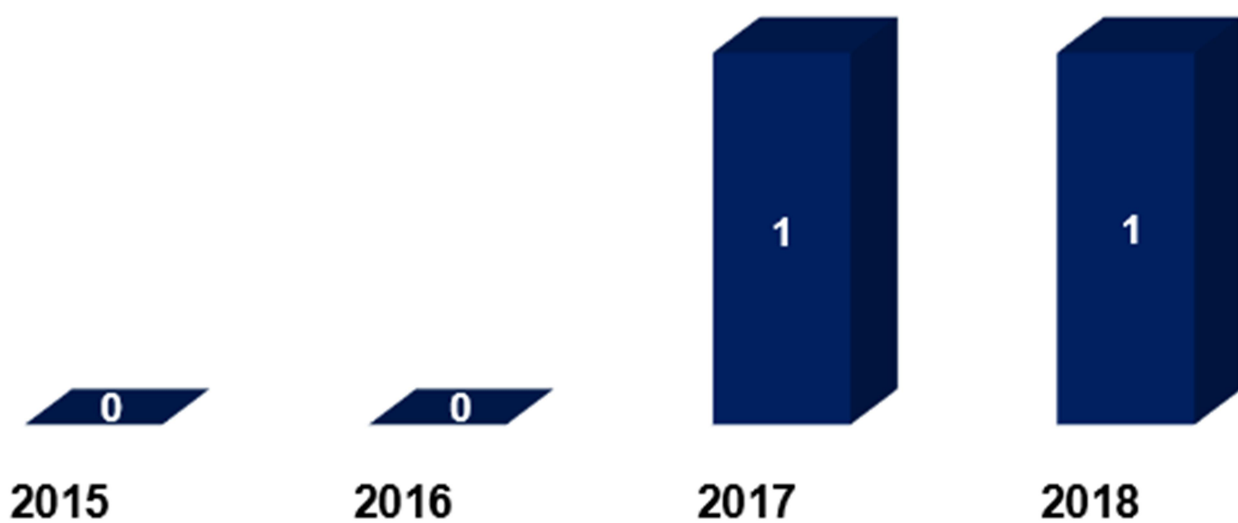
2.2 Received and Selected Tunisia E+ CBHE Projects

Since the results of 2019 accepted CBHE projects are not yet published, we present only the information about the submitted projects. Comparing to 2018, in 2019, there is an increase of **44% in submitted CBHE projects involving Tunisia!**



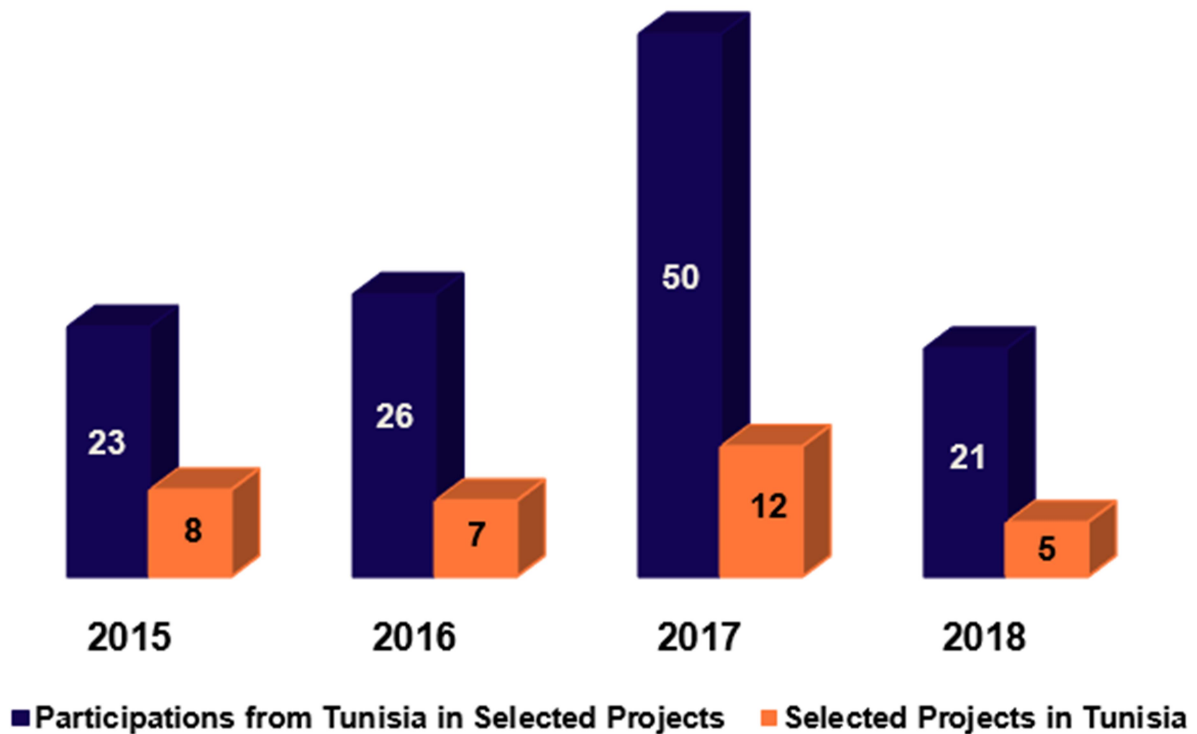
2.3 Accepted Tunisia E+ CBHE Projects Coordinated by a Tunisian University

Until 2018, Tunisia has only two Erasmus+ CBHE projects in which she is the coordinator. In 2019 call, there are 19 submitted projects coordinated by Tunisia, waiting for the final results.

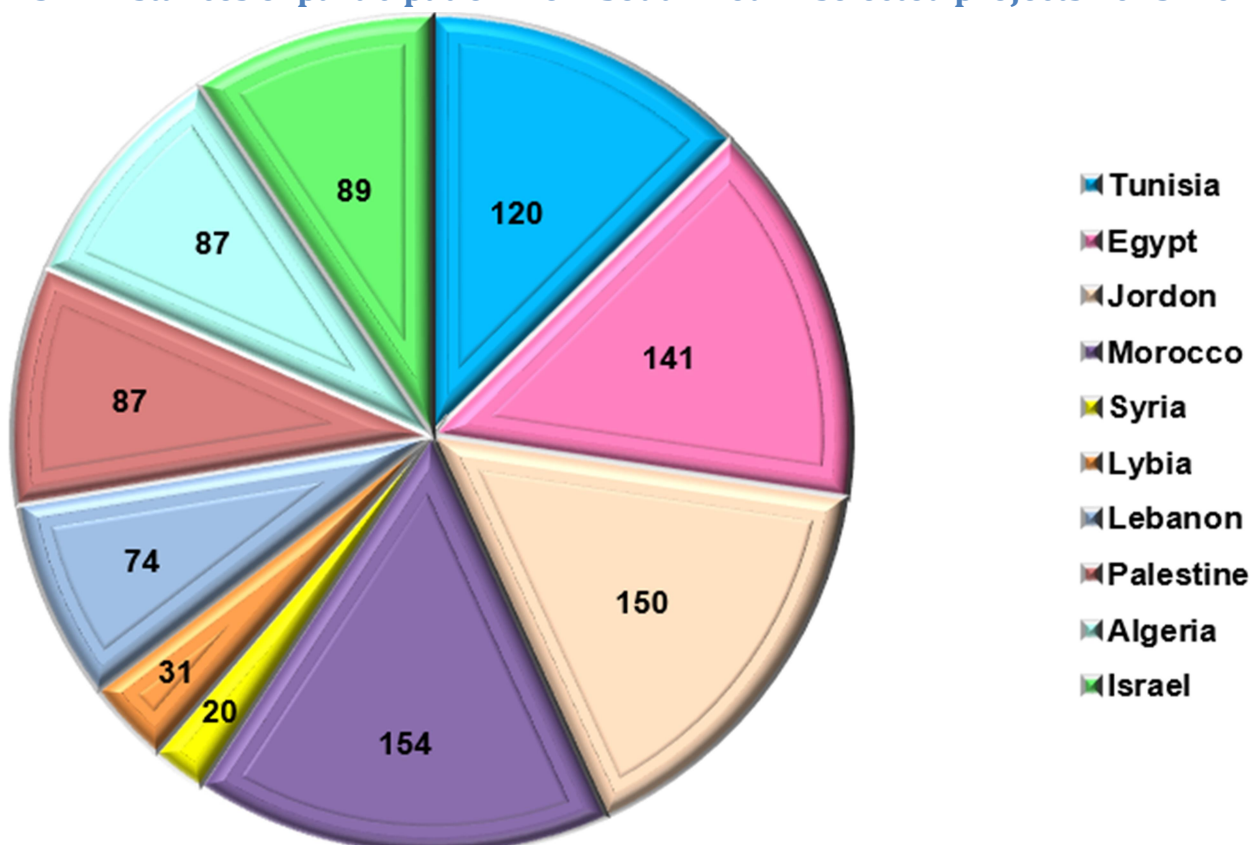


2.4 Instances of participation from Tunisia in selected projects

We present in the following the number of instances participating in the Erasmus+ CBHE projects from 2014 to 2018, with a total number equal to 120 instances during the four years.



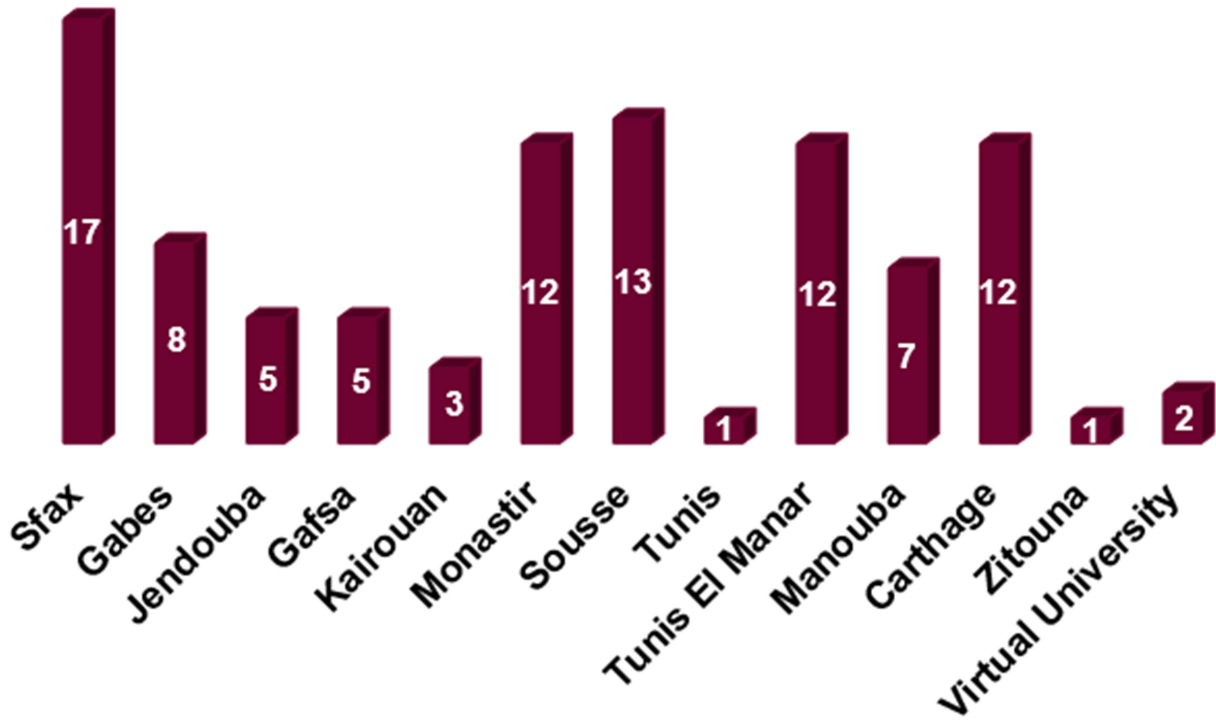
2.5 Instances of participation from South Med in selected projects 2015 -2018



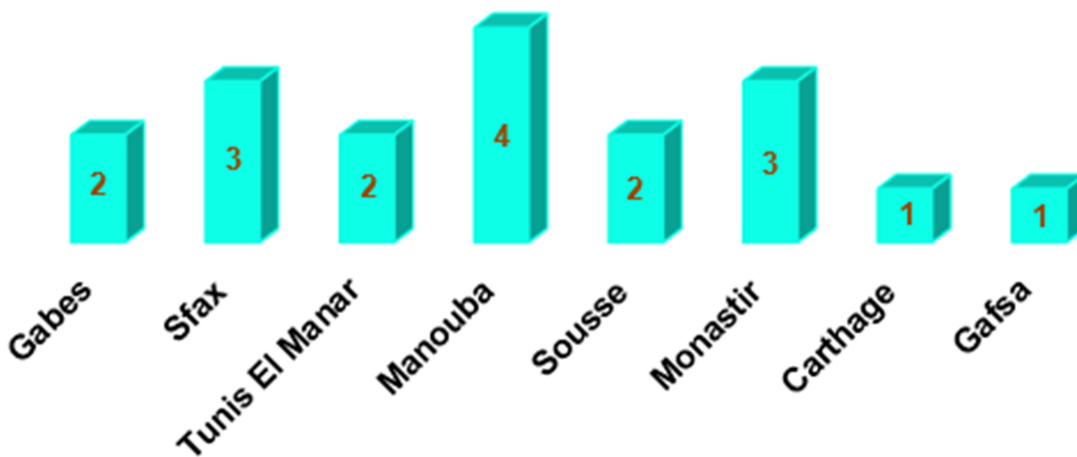
2.6 Evolution of E+ CBHE Projects in Tunisian Universities throughout 2015 to 2018

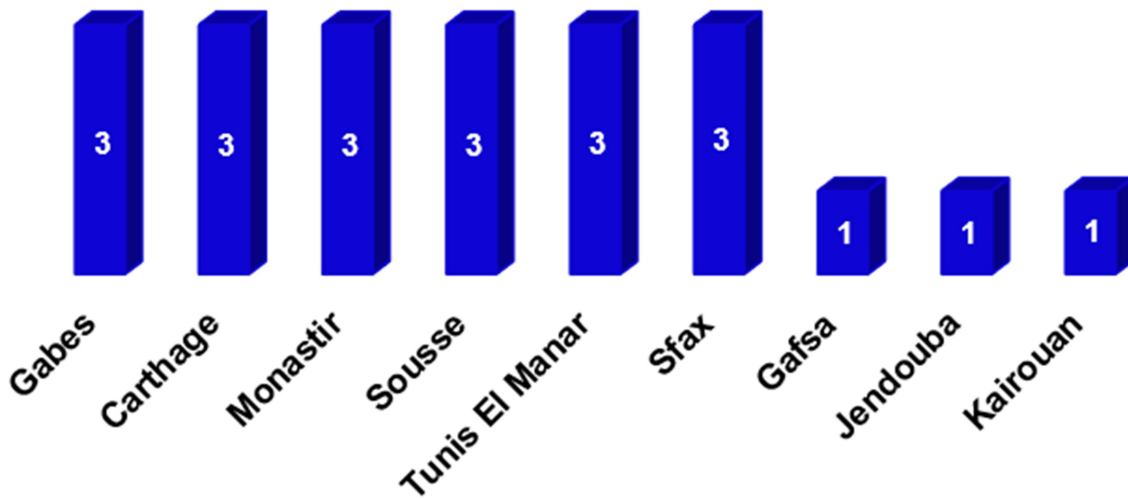
E+ CBHE Projects 2015-2018 by a Tunisian University



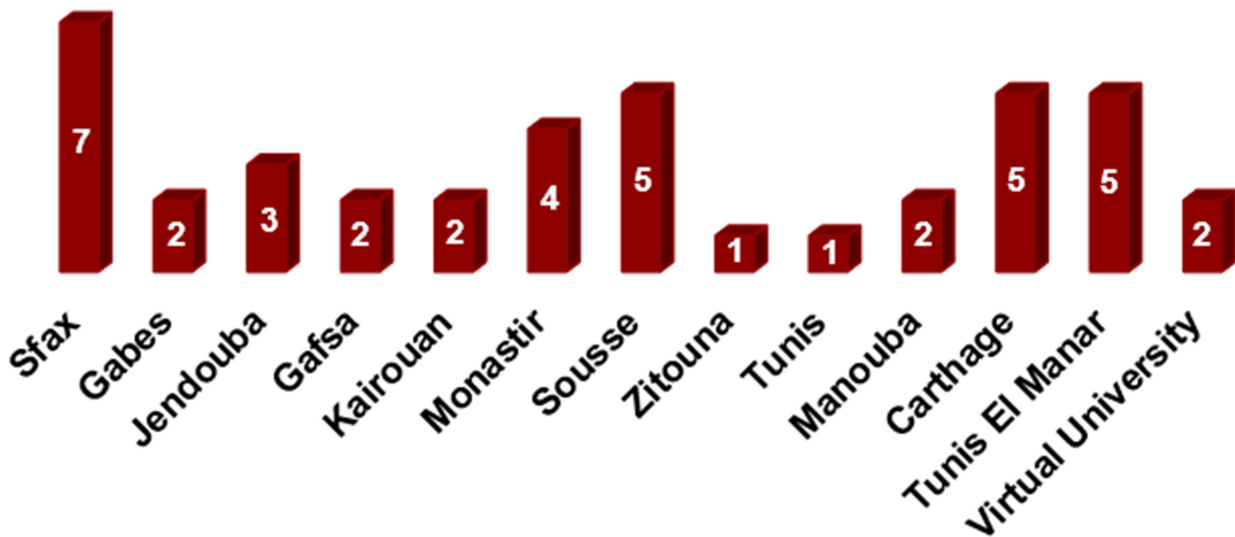
2.6.1 2015: E+ CBHE Projects in Tunisian Universities



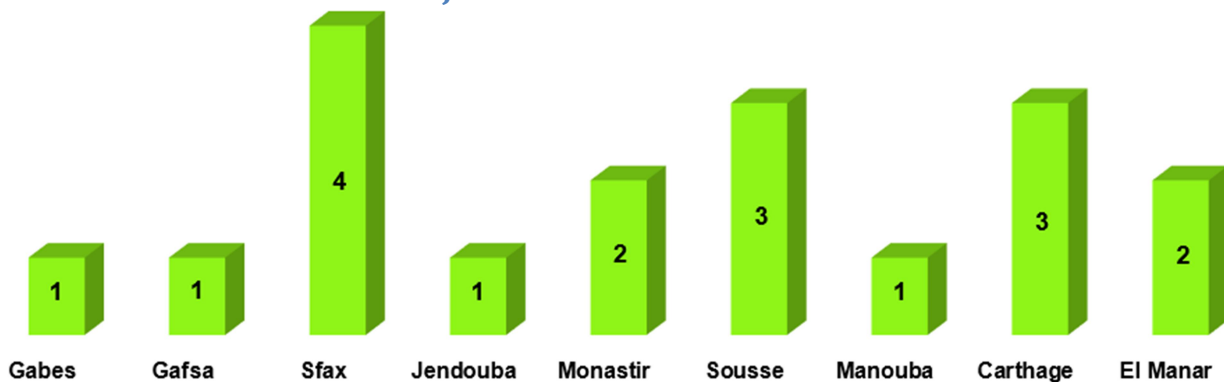
2.6.2 2016: E+ CBHE Projects in Tunisian Universities

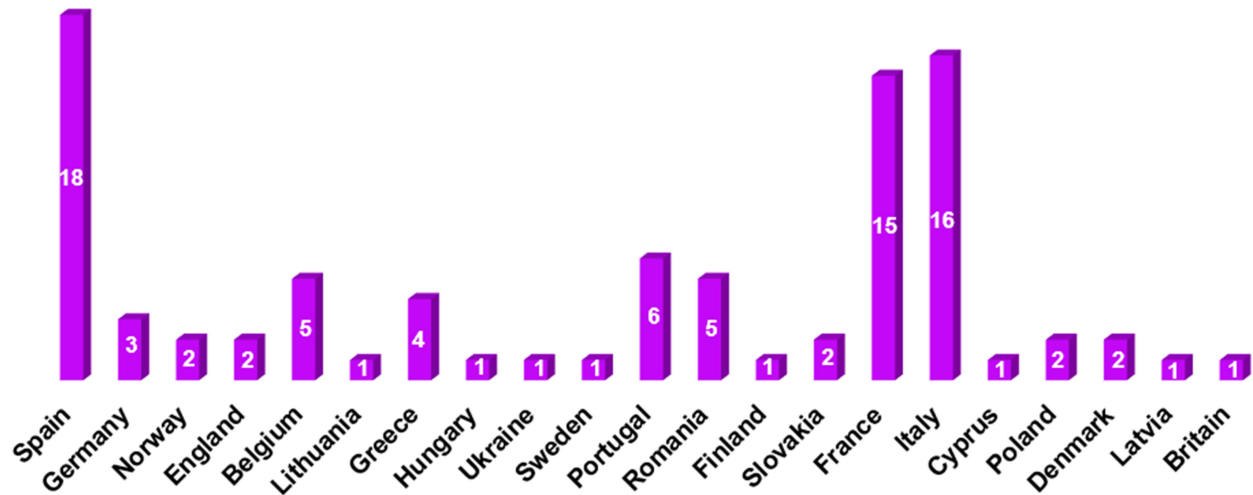

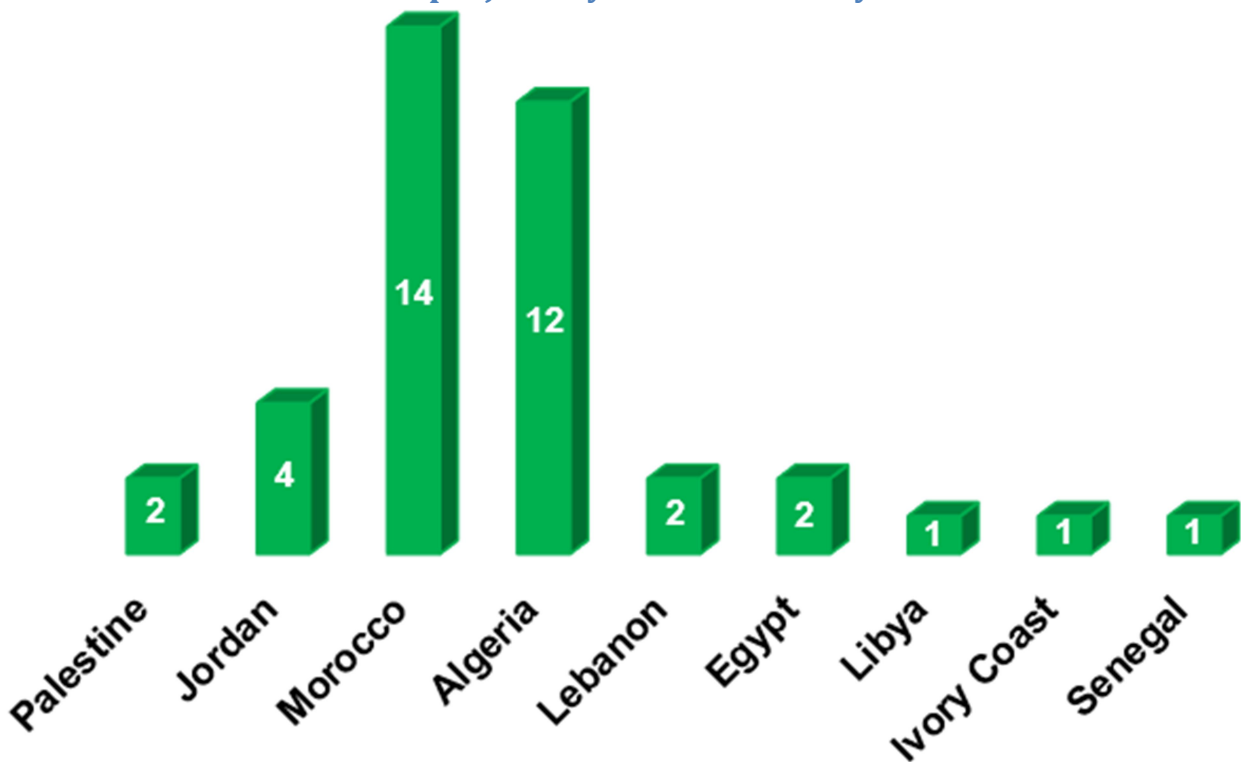
